We received notice today that a new BBC documentary, *Revolutionary Justice in Iran*, will be broadcast repeatedly in the coming days. It will feature footage from the December 1981 trial of the seven male members of the National Spiritual Assembly of the Bahá'ís of Iran, who were later executed. The footage has never before been broadcast.

The first broadcast in Persian will take place tomorrow—Tuesday, October 13, at 9:00 P.M. Tehran time (1:30 P.M. Eastern Daylight Savings Time in the United States) on BBC Persian television and on the BBC Persian website. Check their listings to determine subsequent times.

The first broadcast of the English version of the documentary will be on the BBC World Service on Saturday, October 17, at 5:10 A.M. Greenwich Mean Time (in the United States, 10 minutes after midnight EDST on Saturday morning). Subsequent broadcasts in English will take place at 11:10 A.M. EDST on Saturday, October 17, and at 5:10 A.M. and 5:10 P.M., both on Sunday, October 18.
