

2017 GUIDELINES FOR THE PAT SHELTON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Who is eligible?

Youth 10-25 years of age residing in Southern California. (Note new age range)

What is the maximum scholarship that can be applied for?

This fund pays up to 80% of total registration fees. If there is an early registration discount, we will pay 80% based upon the early registration amount.

Which events are eligible for scholarship?

This fund supports registration fees to permanent or temporary Bahá'í Schools.

How far in advance must I request the scholarship?

All applications should be received at least 4 to 5 weeks prior to the school date session start.

Letters of recommendation from Spiritual Assemblies

Every application must be accompanied by a Spiritual Assembly's recommendation. If a youth resides in a non-Assembly area he/she may request a recommendation from a neighboring Spiritual Assembly.

Does every application get approved?

We evaluate each application on its own merit, and will have a response to the LSA of the requesting youth within 2-3 weeks of receiving the request.
