Message addressed to the Universal House of Justice from the delegates gathered at the 109th Bahá'í National Convention of the United States

To our Beloved Universal House of Justice:

Sheltered in this Holy Mother Temple, we lovingly offer joyous greetings to our Supreme Institution, The Universal House of Justice, lauded by 'Abdu'l-Bahá "as the source of all good and freed from error", and extolled by the Guardian in the Advent of Divine Justice as "the exponent and guardian of that divine justice which can alone insure the security of, and establish the reign of law and order in a strangely disordered world".

Graciously hosted by our National Spiritual Assembly, lovingly encouraged by Counselors Nwandi Lawson and Sonlla Heern, inspired by the Deputy trustees of the sacred Institution of Huququ'llah, invigorated by the participation of 30 new delegates, and through our collective reflection on the Ridván message, we are striving to understand the totality of the vision conveyed in your guidance. With rigour and sacrifice we are learning to nurture the framework for action.

In countless places, in rural settings and urban neighborhoods, we are energized by this single greatest worldwide opportunity to offer a befitting gift to Him who is the Unifier of the World, by acquainting every kind of person with His life, His mission and His matchless Covenant.
